Our winemaking balances disciplined technique with a spirit of exploration, with the goal of capturing energy, structure, and a sense of adventure in every glass of Carboy wine.

Carboy Winery's founding winemaker is Tyzok Wharton, whose vision and drive helped shape the program from the ground up. Drawn to Colorado's untapped potential, Tyzok brings both precision and a willingness to push boundaries in pursuit of something new.

GRAND VALLEY AVA

The Grand Valley AVA, Colorado's first federally designated wine region, is a high-desert frontier where elevation, aridity, and relentless sunshine shape every vine. A short, intense growing season paired with dramatic day-to-night temperature swings drives bold flavor development while locking in vibrant natural acidity. Carved by the Colorado River and layered with diverse soils, this is a place that produces wines with energy, structure, and a distinctly adventurous sense of place. Alongside our estate vineyards, we partner with dedicated local growers who share our commitment to quality, allowing us to capture the full breadth and character of the region.

MT. GARFIELD ESTATE VINEYARD

Located at 4,742 feet in Colorado's Grand Valley AVA, our Mt. Garfield Estate Vineyard sits in a high-desert environment defined by intense sunlight, low rainfall, and dramatic day-to-night temperature swings that preserve acidity and build complexity. Set against the Book Cliffs with northwest exposure and silty clay loam soils, our site produces fruit with structure, depth, and vibrant energy. Originally planted in 2000 and largely replanted in 2021, our vineyard reflects Carboy's commitment to redefining what high-elevation winemaking can achieve.

K VINEYARD

K Vineyard is planted entirely to new-world cultivars, reflecting the next evolution of high-elevation viticulture in Colorado's Grand Valley AVA. Located just southwest of our Mt. Garfield Estate in Clifton at 4,717 feet, the slightly cooler site, combined with northwest exposure and silty clay loam soils, produces fruit with lifted aromatics and vibrant natural acidity. These cold-climate varieties thrive in Colorado's extremes, from sub-zero winters to 100°F summer days, yielding wines with intensity, energy, and layered complexity.





SUSTAINABILITY

We are committed to crafting wines with a deep respect for the land, prioritizing sustainability at every step from grape to glass. Through water conservation, thoughtful vineyard practices, and partnerships that support regenerative agriculture and environmental restoration, we work to reduce our impact while strengthening Colorado's wine future. From innovative packaging that eliminates waste to energy-efficient operations and resource-conscious winemaking, our approach is rooted in preserving the landscapes that make our wines possible.

Through our partnerships, we extend that commitment beyond our vineyard and tasting room. As a proud member of 1% for the Planet, we donate a portion of our sales to Zero Foodprint's Restore Colorado program, supporting regenerative farming practices that rebuild soil health and capture carbon. We also partner with Protect Our Rivers, working to conserve and restore the waterways that are vital to Colorado's ecosystems and the future of agriculture.
