TASTING NOTES:

Our 2024 Rosé is bold, vibrant and rich in color. The blend of Marquette, Frontenac and Chambourcin gives juicy notes of strawberry daiquiri, watermelon, raspberry sherbet and hibiscus in each sip. It's crisp, dry and refreshing on its own and also pairs well with savory dishes and BBQ. Take a sip on the dark side of rosé!

VINTAGE NOTES - 2024:

The 2024 vintage in Colorado's Grand Valley will be remembered for its challenges — and its rewards. A late-spring freeze in May cut yields, but the vines rallied, giving us fruit of remarkable intensity. July's heat pushed ripening forward, while August's cooler days and crisp desert nights slowed things down just enough to let flavors deepen, acids hold, and structure develop with grace. Harvest arrived 10–12 days ahead of average, pushing crews to move quickly before fall frost, yet the fruit remained healthy, with robust skins and lively acids.

Though volume is down, the quality is undeniable. The wines of 2024 shine with vibrancy and elegance — vivid aromatics, balanced sugars, and a terroir-driven energy that captures the drama and beauty of farming at the edge of the Rockies.
